I, Lula C. Harling

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Lula C. Harling
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to
Elizabeth S. Whitmire

in the full and just sum of Fifteen hundred
Dollars, to be paid one hundred dollars on December 5th, 1921 and one hundred dollars on the
fifty day of each month thereafter until paid in full, with the right to anticipate any
and all payments

with interest thereon from the date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid monthly
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10% besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Lula C. Harling
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said
Elizabeth S. Whitmire

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said
Lula C. Harling

in hand well and truly paid by the said
Elizabeth S. Whitmire
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Elizabeth S. Whitmire, All that certain piece, parcel

or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid in Ward 2 of the
City of Greenville, on the east side of Vannoy Street, and having the following dimensions
to-wit: Fronting on Vannoy Street 55 feet and running back in parallel lines a distance of
217 feet and being known as lot No. 33 of Section H, of a plat of Stone Land Company, said
plat recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in plat book A., pages 337-345
and being one of the lots deeded to Floride L. Miller by Stone Land Company, June 25, 1909
and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Volume XXX, page 84 and afterwards
deeded by Floride L. Miller to Elizabeth S. Whitmire, June 3rd, 1914, and recorded in the
R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 27, page 31.
