until paid in full; all interest not when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of one percent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bertha Lemort the following described

Real Estate to wit: - Beginning at a chestnut the beginning corner of a tract of land conveyed by A Justice to P. L. Wright and running thence along the line of the Johnson Tract north 39 degrees East 1077 feet to a stake in the center of the Asheville Greenville Highway; thence with the center of the Asheville Greenville Highway; about north 30 deg. West about 653 feet to a stake; thence with the ward line S. 73 deg. W. 1100 feet to the chestnut tree the beginning corner containing about 7 acres, the same being tract 4, as shown on the plat of the lands of P. L. Wright, which plat is duly recorded in the Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances for Greenville County South Carolina in Book - page -

Second Tract.
