I, C.E. Mayfield SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, C.E. Mayfield, the said C.E. Mayfield
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to H.S. Wood

in the full and just sum of One thousand
Dollars, to be paid one year from date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten percent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note. to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, C.E. Mayfield
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said H.S. Wood

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said C.E. Mayfield

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H.S. Wood, All that certain tract of land lying and

being situate in Austin Township, County and State aforesaid, near the Town of Simpson-
ville, and being cut from and a portion of a 28-33 acre tract of land which is described
in a deed from F.M. Burdett to F.L. Mayfield, recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville
County in Book 55, at page 112, this certain tract of land containing 9.02 acres,
according to a survey by W.J. Riddle, Surveyor, Feb. 12, 1921, and having the following
metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone 3x0m in field and running thence N. 54-10 E. 12.50 to a stone
3x0m; thence N. 14-45 W. 5.13 to pin in Georgia Road; thence along said road S. 83-40
W. 7.14 to bend; thence further along said road S. 57-50 W. 4.65 to iron pin 3x0m; thence
S. 14.00 E. 9.24 to the beginning corner, and being the same land conveyed to me by
F.L. Mayfield by deed dated the 21st, day of Dec. 1921, recorded in the office of R.M.C.
for Greenville County in Book 79 at page 239, and being bounded by lands of
