thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference

Township, containing Ten acres, more or less. Adjoining
lands of Wm Priestley, Arthur McJunkin, William Fleming
& Jamies Thompson, and being the same land conveyed
to me by Enoch Burns, Dec 20th. 1921.
