computed and paid at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be

until paid in full; all interest now and when due, to bear interest at the same rate as principal, and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent (10%) besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

Township, in the County and State aforesaid, and containing Ten acres (10) more or less,  
and having the following lines, metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the  
White Horse Road, joint corner of tracts Nos. 4 and 5 and running thence S. 86.10 E. 25.00  
to an iron pin nm; thence N. 8-1/2 W. 3.57 to stone om; thence N. 87-1/2 W. 13.80 to stone om;  
thence N. 2-1/2 E. 3.32 to P.O. stone gone; thence N. 87-1/2 W. 8.80 to an iron pin at the  
White Horse Road; thence along said White Horse Road 6.20 chains to iron pin at the beginning
