interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which are secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference

All those lots or parcels of land situate in the State and
County aforesaid, near the Laurens Road and East of
the City of Greenville designated as parts of Lots Nos. 12
and 13 in subdivision of Eastover, as shown on plat
recorded in Plat Book 7, page 42, having the following
metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at a stake in line of Lot No. 13, on Beech-
wood Avenue and 3 feet west of corner of Lots Nos.
12 and 13 and running thence with said Avenue, 102.
9 feet to iron pin, corner of Beech wood Avenue and
Glen Street, thence with Glen Street in a curved line,
