computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

twenty-five dollars besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Henry P. McGee, his heirs and assigns, all that piece,

parcel or lot of land situate in Ward Six of the City of Greenville, County and State
aforesaid on Glenn Street, containing one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of one acre, more or less and
consisting of two lots fronting on Glenn Street and running back to right of way of
C. & G. R.R. Co., being the same land conveyed to me by B.M. McGee, 9th, August 1918.
