

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Bell Tollison, of Greenville, in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Bell Tollison, in and by my certain bond or obligation, bearing date the 21st day of December 1922, stand firmly held and bound unto THE CAROLINA LOAN AND TRUST COMPANY, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the penal sum of Thirteen Hundred & no/100 (\$1300.00)

conditioned for the payment of the full and just sum of Six hundred Fifty & no/100 (\$650.00) Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 21st day of December A. D. 1922

according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of said Company, in manner and form the following, that is to say, that I, the said Bell Tollison shall pay, or cause to be paid, to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors, or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th day, or before the end of the month of December 1922, and on the 20th, or before the end of each month thereafter, for twenty successive months, the sum

Ten & 83/100 (\$10.83) Dollars (\$6.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the 6 1/2 shares of stock, and Four & 33/100 (\$4.33) Dollars

being the monthly interest on the advance or loan), until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Nine & 97/100 (\$9.97) Dollars (\$6.50) Dollars,

being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Three & 47/100 (\$3.47) Dollars being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Nine & 10/100 (\$9.10) Dollars,

(\$6.50) Dollars being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Two & 60/100 (\$2.60) Dollars being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Eight & 23/100 (\$8.23) Dollars (\$6.50) Dollars,

being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and One & 73/100 (\$1.73) Dollars being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Seven & 99/100 (\$7.99) Dollars,

(\$6.50) Dollars being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Eighty seven cents (\$0.87) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due).

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th, or before the last day, of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said 6 1/2 shares of stock and the certificate thereon, the amount at such time paid on the said shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me, the said Bell Tollison and shall pay or cause to be paid, all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me, the said Bell Tollison

in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said bond or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Bell Tollison, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said THE CAROLINA LOAN AND TRUST COMPANY, according to the condition of the said bond or obligation, and also in consideration of the other sum of FIVE DOLLARS, to me the said Bell Tollison

in hand well and truly paid by the said THE CAROLINA LOAN AND TRUST COMPANY, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and, by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said THE CAROLINA LOAN AND TRUST COMPANY, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina, about two miles from Greenville Court House in the subdivision known as Pendleton Heights, and shown on plat made by W. P. Meves, December 1912, and known as lot No. 12 on said plat, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Gentry Street, 625 ft. from the north side of Pendleton Road, and running thence with Gentry street in a northeasterly direction 50 ft. to an iron pin; Thence with the line of lot No. 14 in a northwesterly direction 150 ft. to an iron pin; Thence in a southwesterly direction parallel with Gentry street 50 ft. to iron pin; Thence in a southwesterly direction with line of lot No. 10, 150 to iron pin. The beginning corner, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Wm. H. Sivine by deed recorded in volume 62, page 372, R. M. C. office for Greenville County.
