kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said *J. S. Gilreath*

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better

securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and

released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Mrs. L. M. Bauskett*

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in *Greenville*

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville on the northwest corner of

Brier and Grove Streets and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake at the northwest corner of Brier and Grove Streets and running thence in a westerly direction with Grove Street 100 feet to a stake; thence in a northerly direction in a line parallel with Brier Street 65 feet to stake; thence in an easterly direction in a line parallel with Grove Street 100 feet to stake on Brier Street; and thence with Brier Street in a southerly direction 65 feet to the beginning corner.
