and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto and will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that the said George Red League

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said L. E. Curtis

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in the Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina

About two miles north of the City of Greenville, near Monaghan Mill and having the following metes and bounds according to the plat of Morgan Hill Addition, same recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, pages 68 and 69, beginning at an iron pin on Morgan street, joint corner of lots nos. 31 and 32, and running N. 7 1/4 W. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 82 3/4 W. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 7 1/4 E. 200 feet to an iron pin on Morgan street; thence along Morgan street N. 82 3/4 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner, being lot no. 31 on the above mentioned plat.
