NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said J. B. Norris

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me in hand well and truly paid and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Allan J. Graham

all that piece or parcel of land situated in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina

In the City of Greenville, in the Fourth Ward of said City, on the South side of Lois street, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the Southwest side of Lois street 180 feet from the intersection of Lois street and Oaklawn Avenue, joint corner lots nos. 21 and 22, and running thence with line of lot no. 21, S. 24-50 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 62-19 E. 60 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots nos. 22 and 23, thence with line of lot no. 23, N. 34-50 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on Lois street, thence with said street N. 62-19 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner and being known as Lot no. 22, as shown on plat of Oakland Heights, recorded in Plat Book C, page 147.
