WHEREAS, I, *M. J. Mosley*

am well and truly indebted to *Pioneer Life Insurance Company, a Corporation of South Carolina* in the full and just sum of *Two Thousand* $\frac{200}{100}$

Dollars, in and by *my* certain promissory note in writing, of even date herewith, due and payable on the day of *July*, 192*5*. *In installments of forty dollars per month, due and payable on the first day of each calendar month, beginning July 1st, 1925. (said installments to be applied first to the payment of interest and then to the payment of principal)* with interest from *date* at the rate of *seven* per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid *semi* annually

and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, *M. J. Mosley*

for and in full consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note, I have also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Pioneer Life Insurance Company*

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in *Greenville* Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, *about two miles from the City of Greenville, near Paris*

Mountain Road, designated as lot No. 29 on plat of Ten acres of the property of A.G. New on the Paris Mountain Road, made by R.E. Dalton, Surveyor, and recorded in office of R.M.C. for said County in Plat Book C, page 199, and having the following courses and distances according to said plat: Beginning at a stake on the west side of Duke Street, corner of lot No. 28 and running thence with Duke Street N. 4-20 W. 70 feet to stake, corner of lot No. 30; thence with line of lot #30 S. 85-40 W. 150 feet to stake corner of lot No. 31; thence with line of said lot S. 4-20 E. 70 feet to stake, corner of lot No. 28; thence with said lot N. 85-40 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner, being part of the same conveyed to me by A.G.
