WHEREAS, I, the said J. R. Balentine

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, and well and truly indebted to

Melville C. Westervelt, as Trustee in the full and just sum of Five Hundred, Thirty and 62/100 (\$530.62)

Dollars, to be paid as follows: One-fourth six months after date; One-fourth twelve months after date; One-fourth eighteen months after date, and One-fourth twenty-four months after date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Melville C. Westervelt, as Trustee, All that certain lot or parcel

of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, known and designated as Lot No. 64 in Block "D" of the subdivision known as Augusta Court as shown on a plat of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in the Plat Book "F", page 124, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Augusta Court, joint corner of lots Nos. 63 and 64, thence with the joint line of said lots N. 50-42 E. 163.8 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot No. 66; thence with the line of said lot S. 39-18 E. 60 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 65; thence with line of that lot S. 50-42 W. 149.8 feet to an iron pin on Augusta Court; thence with Augusta Court N. 52-41 W. 61.6 feet to the point of beginning. This mortgage is given to secure a portion of the purchase price of the above described lot of land.
