may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten (10%) per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to

designated upon plat of property of W. D. Workman, made by C. M. Furman, Engr., dated September
11th, 1922, as Lot No. 6, and being more specifically described as follows:
Beginning at a point on the National Highway, joint corner of lots Nos. 5 and 6, and running
thence N. 55-40 E. 21.05 feet to a point on said National Highway, joint corner of lots No. 6
and 7; thence along line of lots Nos. 6 and 7, N. 30-40 W. 71.33 feet to point on line of
lot No. 8, joint corner of lots Nos. 6 and 7; thence along line of Lot No. 8, S. 59-20 W. 21
feet to point on line of Lot No. 8, joint corner of lots Nos. 5 and 6; thence along line of
