WHEREAS, **I**, the said **J.W. Kirkpatrick**

in and by **my** certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to **AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION**, a corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the full and just sum of **Eighty-five hundred and no/100 (\$8500.00)** Dollars,

to be paid on or before the date when the **10th** day of **August** next, or **Instalment**

Kirkpatrick** in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said **AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION**, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, **no** the said **J.W. Kirkpatrick**

in hand well and truly paid by the said **AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION** at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION** and its successors and assigns forever: All that certain parcel or

lot of land situate, lying and being on the northeast corner of Stone Avenue and Wilton Street in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake at said corner and running thence with Stone Avenue S. 84-1/2 E. 131 feet to stake; thence N. 5-1/2 E. 200 feet to the line of lot formerly owned by Mountain City Land and Improvement Company; thence N. 84-1/2 W. 131 feet to stake on Wilton Street; thence along Wilton Street S. 5-1/2 W. 200 feet to the beginning corner, containing sixty-one one hundredths (61/100) of an acre, more or less, and being the same lot of land conveyed by W.F.C. Owens to J.W. Kirkpatrick by deed yet to be recorded.
