I, L.L. Baty, of the County and State aforesaid SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said L.L. Baty

in and by me certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, a corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of South Carolina, in the full and just sum of Twenty-eight hundred (\$2800.00) Dollars,

to be paid on or before the date when the 15th. Series of the instalment

Stock of the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION shall reach maturity, with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly on or before Saturday night of each and every week until paid in full; and if I

fail to pay said interest or to comply in all respects with the By-Laws of said Association, for the space of thirty days, then said debt shall become immediately due and payable, together with all interest, fines and expenses, and all amounts advanced by the said Association on the within described property, by way of taxes or insurance, the same to be added to the amount due on said note and to be collectible as part thereof, together with an attorney's fee of ten per cent. if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection of said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage), as provided in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said

L.L. Baty in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said L.L. Baty

in hand well and truly paid by the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being about

one and one-half miles from the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid, and having the following and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a point on unnamed street joint corners of lots Nos. 33 and 32, and running thence N. 34-15 E. 220 feet to a point; thence S. 49-15 E. 68.9 feet to a point; thence S. 34-15 W. 227 feet to a point on unnamed street; thence N. 45-15 W. 70 feet to the point of beginning. Being known as lot No. 33 of C.F. Putman land, see plat book F, page 240.

Also all that lot of land situate as above and described as follows: Beginning at a point of unnamed Street, joint corner of lots No. 35 and 34, and running thence N. 34-15 E. 234 feet to a point; thence S. 49-56 E. 68.9 feet to a point; thence S. 34-15 W. 241 feet to a point on unnamed street; thence N. 45-15 W. 70 feet to the point of beginning. Being known as Lot No. 35 of said C.F. Putman land. These two lots of land being a part of the land conveyed to me by Putman by deed dated the 30th, day of September 1924, and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 92, page 544.

It is understood that Twelve hundred (\$1200.00) Dollars of the principal is secured by Lot No. 33 and Sixteen hundred (\$1600.00) Dollars of the principal is secured by lot No. 35.
