SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we the said Pauline M. Epstein and Philip E. Levy

ALL THAT certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being

in Ward Three of the City of Greenville in the County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pipe at the northeast corner of Hudson and Oscar Streets and running thence N. 23-45 E. 136.5 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 53-0 E. 132 feet to a stake; thence S. 65-0 E. 124.5 feet to an iron pipe at the corner of a 17 feet alley; thence with line of said alley S. 20-57 W. 166.7 feet to an iron pipe at the corner of said alley and Oscar Street; thence with Oscar Street N. 55-12 W. 268 feet to an iron pipe the beginning corner.

Also, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the south side of Oscar Street, beginning at a point on Oscar Street 54 feet West of the corner of Mayfield and Oscar Streets and running thence with Oscar Street N. 54-52 W. 120.5 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 23-30 W. 98.8 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 54 E. 22 feet to the corner of an alley; thence N. 35-08 E. 8 feet to rear corner of lot No. 3; thence S. 54-0 E. with line of an 8 foot alley 79 feet to rear corner of lots Nos. 1 and 2; thence N. 35-08 E. 90.1 feet to an iron pin on Oscar Street the beginning corner. Gower by deed recorded in Volume 70, page 558, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.
