in hand well and truly paid by the AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION

AND LOAN ASSOCIATION that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township,

Greenville County, South Carolina, just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being a part of lot No. 23 of Overbrook subdivision, according to a plat of said subdivision as made by H. Olin Jones in September 1913 and recorded in Office of R.M.C. for said County and State, reference to which plat is hereby made; said lot of land herein conveyed being described by metes and bounds as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of lot No. 23 of Overbrook Subdivision according to plat aforesaid, and running thence S. 27-55 W. along the division line between lots 22 and 23 of said subdivision 78.7 feet, more or less to a stake 70 feet from the southwest corner of said lot No. 23 as shown on said plat; thence running S. 65-13 E. along a line parallel to the Southern line of said lot 23, 107.6 feet, more or less, to a stake on the western line of Walnut Street as shown on said plat, said stake being 70 feet distant along said west line of Walnut Street, from the southeastern corner of said lot No. 23; thence along said western line of Walnut Street as shown on said plat, N. 38-11 E. 105.3 feet to a stake on the western line of a certain unnamed Street shown on said plat; thence along the western line of said unnamed street 17.6 feet to a stake; thence N. 81-20 W. continuing along said Street, a distance of 44.3 feet to a stake; thence still along said street N. 81-18 W. 28.1 feet to a stake; thence still along said Street N. 69-16 W. 47 feet to the northwest corner of said lot 23, the point of beginning, being the same conveyed to me by Woodville Investment Company by deed dated October 8, 1923.
