even date with these presents, *and* well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of *Eight Hundred (\$800.00)*
Dollars, to be paid *November 4, 1923*

with interest thereon, from *the 11th day of Dec. 1941* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid *semi-annually in full*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
