Connolly in the full and just sum of Three Thousand, seven hundred forty-eight dollars and fifty cents (\$3748.50) to be paid May 5, 1926, with interest thereon from May the 5, 1925 at the rate of eight per cent (8%) per annum, to be computed and paid annually until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal: said note provides for an attorneys fee of ten per cent to be added to the principal and interest if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or any part thereof, or by legal proceedings of any kind as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said.....W.B. Connolly, his heirs and assigns all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Grove Township, State and County aforesaid, containing thirty and three-fourths acres (30-3/4) more or less, adjoining the lands of John Tripp, Estate of B.E. Owens, A. McMahan and others and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by T.E. Creswell by deed dated November 5, 1908 and recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Volume ZZZ, at page 406, reference to which the calls of said land can be had.

The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, S.C., holds a mortgage for Sixteen hundred and fifty dollars on this tract of land, dated Feb. 20, 1919, and the said Federal Land Bank now holds the insurance Policy on the house located on said land.

To better secure the payment of the debt secured by this mortgage the said W.T. McMahan has endorsed and turned over to the said W.B. Connolly the Notes and mortgages he holds on J.O. Williams and Lee Suber, colored of Greenville County and State of South Carolina.
