Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows to-wit:

All that certain lot of land, situate on the West side of Calhoun Street in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, known and designated as lot number 33 on plat recorded in R. 72, C. Office for Greenville County, Plat Book 27, page 225, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake on Calhoun Street 43 feet from the Northwest corner of Calhoun and Dunbar Streets and thence with line of lot adjoining N. 78 W. 200 feet to an alley; thence with said alley N. 78 W. 43 feet to stake, thence S. 76 E. 200 feet to Calhoun Street; thence with Calhoun Street S. 18 W. 43 feet to the beginning corner, being the same, lot conveyed to res by deed recorded Vol. 68, page 237.
