Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and r lease unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of the old White Horse Road, joint corner of the land of J. H. Wildaure and D. H. Johnson and running thence S. 76-10 E. 170 feet to a stake; thence S. 9-30 W. 60 feet to a stake; thence N. 76-10 W. 170 feet to a stake on the east side of the Old Whitehorse Road; thence with said Road N. 9-30 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by N. L. Langston by deed dated February 6th, 1924 and recorded in R. M. C. Office in Book 92, page 305.
