VonHallen in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the date of delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Sallie H. all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Kantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near Welcome School, having the following courses and

distances, according to survey and plat made by R.E. Dalton, Engineer, in January 1922, and revised in October 1923; beginning at an iron pin on the South side of road leading from Welcome School to the Odd Fellows Orphanage, 1165 feet from center of the White Horse Road, corner of tract No. 1 and running thence with line of tract No. 1, S. 0-55 E. 1043.4 feet to iron pin in line of Cochran; thence with Cochran line S. 58-53 W. 860 feet to stake, corner of tract No. 3; thence with line of tract No. 3, N. 20 E. 1533 feet to stake on road leading from Welcome School to Odd Fellows Orphanage; thence with said road N. 74-55 E. 200 feet to the beginning containing 11.84 acres, more or less.
