Dollars, in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date herewith, due and payable on the 12th day of April, 1929.

at the rate of eight per cent per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid semi annually, and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and I have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for a lawyer's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I Marion B Leach

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the signing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Kate Cushman

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 56.9 acres, more or less on Mid Creek waters of Grove Creek, about seven miles from the City of Greenville, adjoining lands of J. A. Astley, J. J. Myer and Frances A. Myers, being all that remains of the 63.9 acres conveyed to Marion B Leach by Charles J. Brock by deed, dated September 27, 1919, recorded in Book 53, page 169, after the conveyance by Marion B Leach of a tract of 6 acres to J. A. Platen. See Plat Book E, Page 172.
