NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said D.E. Tripp

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me

in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Carrie Reinach

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about two and one-half miles West of Greenville Court House, directly opposite Graceland Cemetery on Pendleton Road, known as Lots number thirteen, fourteen, fifteen and twenty-two on plat of property of W.D. Workman made by C.M. Furman, Engineer in October 1924, said plat being recorded in office of R.M.U. for said County in Plat Book G, page 14.
