who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of.....

fifty dollars besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note....., to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note.....,

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said G. Dancy O'Neal his heirs and assigns

Berie Station in the County of Greenville, State of said  
being known and designated as lot number two of the  
property of W. D. Currier as shown by plat made by R. E.  
Waltan and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville  
County in plat book E at page 46, and having  
according to said plat the following meter and bounds  
to-wit:
