

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

That I, Mary Angel of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, Mary Angel, the said Mary Angel, in and by my certain note or obligation bearing date the 17th day of August 1923

and am indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Four thousand + no/100 (\$4,000.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 17th day of August, A. D. 1923, according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

I the said Mary Angel shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of August 1923 (and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Sixty Six + 67/100

Dollars, (\$66.67) being the regular monthly installment payable on the Forty (40) Shares of Stock, and Twenty Six + 67/100 Dollars, (\$26.67)

Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Sixty One + 33/100 Dollars, (\$61.33)

Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Twenty One + 33/100 Dollars, (\$21.33) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Fifty Six + 29/100 Dollars, (\$56.29)

Dollars, (\$56.29) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Sixteen + no/100 Dollars, (\$16.00) Dollars, being the monthly interest (on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Fifty + 67/100 Dollars, (\$50.67)

Dollars, (\$50.67) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Four + 33/100 Dollars, (\$4.33) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Forty Five + 33/100 Dollars, (\$45.33)

Dollars, (\$45.33) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Five + 33/100 Dollars, (\$5.33) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said Forty shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against I the said Mary Angel

in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That Mary Angel the said Mary Angel in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me

the said Mary Angel in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

In the City of Greenville on the West side of Bowley Street and being the Southern end of Lot No. 36 of the Stone Island Co plat recorded in Plat Book A Page 39 and conveyed to me by James Angel by deed dated June 27th 1907 recorded in Volume 44 page 114, Greenville County Records said lot begins at corner of Lot No. 38 on Bowley Street thence N. 20-19 E. 52 1/2 feet, thence N. 69-29 S. W. 210 feet to alley, thence with alley S. 20-19 W. 52 1/2 feet to lot no. 38, thence S. 69-29 E. 210 feet to the beginning corner.
