

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

That I, J. A. Carrup, of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said J. A. Carrup, in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 17th day of December 1929

was indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Five Hundred & no/100 (\$500.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 17th day of December A. D. 1929, according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

I the said J. A. Carrup shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of December 1929, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Eight & 33/100 (\$8.33) Dollars, (\$8.00) Dollars,

being the regular monthly installment payable on the five (5) Shares of Stock, and Three & 33/100 (\$3.33) Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance (or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Seven & 67/100 (\$7.67) Dollars, (\$5.00) Dollars, being the the regular monthly payment on said stock and Two & 67/100 (\$2.67) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);

for the next twenty months the sum of Seven & no/100 (\$7.00) Dollars, (\$5.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Two & no/100 (\$2.00) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Six & 33/100 (\$6.33) Dollars, (\$3.00) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Three & 33/100 (\$3.33) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);

for the next twenty months pay the sum of Five & 67/100 (\$5.67) Dollars, (\$5.00) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Six & 67/100 (\$6.67) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said five (5) shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made, the said and shall pay or cause to be paid all fees which may be lawfully imposed upon, or charged against, the said

J. A. Carrup, in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said J. A. Carrup, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to the said

J. A. Carrup, in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

Just outside of the corporate limits of Greenville known as Lot No. "0" in plat of survey of land of W.M. Norwood, and known as Norwood Heights, made by J.N. Southern, Surveyor bearing date of Oct. 9th, 1906 and recorded in Office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book A, page 133. Said lot has a frontage on West side of Vance Street of fifty (50) feet and a depth of one hundred fifty (150) feet and has the following notes and bounds. Beginning on Southwest corner of Birnie and Vance Streets; thence with Birnie Street N. 74 W. 150 feet; thence S. 15 1/2 W. 50 feet to corner of Lot No. 1; thence S. 74 E. 150 feet to Vance Street; thence with Vance Street N. 15 1/2 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot conveyed to me by W.M. Norwood by deed dated October 26th, 1909 and recorded in Volume 5, page 88, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.
