

Also: All these pieces, parcels or lots of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11, on sketch of part of Stella K. Tindal estate, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, February, 1931, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a point on the North side of Tindal Avenue, in the City of Greenville, 183 feet east of the North East intersection of Tindal Avenue and Houston Street and running thence along Northern side of Tindal Avenue N. 89-40 E. 274 feet, to corner of an unnamed Street; thence along said unnamed Street in a Northerly direction 249 feet to a bend in said Street; thence continuing along the same N. 13-20 E. 113 feet more or less, to the corner of another unnamed Street; thence along Southern side of said unnamed Street S. 88-26 W. 270 feet to line of property sold to J. D. Neal; thence along line of property of J. D. Neal and property of William and Annie Frances Fleming, S. 1-50 W. 179.8 feet; more or less, to point in line of lot No. 2; thence along line of lot #2 N. 89-40 E. 8 feet to the North East corner of said lot No. 2; thence along Eastern side of lot No. 2 S. 1-50 W. 175 feet to the beginning corner. Being part of the land conveyed to Stella K. Tindal by H. E. Tindal by deed dated July 2, 1927, and recorded in deed Book 124 at page 360.
