WHEREAS, I, Mance M. Jackson
in and by my certain note in writing, of

with interest thereon, from maturity at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent. of the amount besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,
reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

all those two certain lots or tracts of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, (1) tract containing ten acres, on the Cot Bridge road, bounded by lands of Haynsworth Dan Hill estate, Wade Floyd, conveyed to me by Wade Floyd deed recorded in Vol. 44 page 554, R. (2) Lot containing about two acres near Graceland Cemetery, being the lot whereon I now reside and the same conveyed to me by Greenville Cemetery Association, deed recorded in Vol. 172 page 19 said R. M. C. office.
