interest be at any time past due and unpaid then the whole amount evidenced by said note become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent of amount due besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or

Thompson's land, dated August 21, 1920 made by Furman
Cureton and having the following metes and bounds
to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the West side of the
old Spartanburg road (North Street Extension) at the
Northwest corner of said lot No. 5, as shown on said
plat, said beginning point being also designated
at the Southeast corner of the said lot and running
thence in a westerly direction along the line of lots
5 and 6 of said sub-division, 200 feet to a stake on
an alley thence along the east line of said alley 60
