

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, that I, Frank C. Moore

of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said Frank C. Moore in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing the 21st day of November 1924

I am indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of One thousand + no/100 (\$1000.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 21st day of November A. D. 1924, according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that I

the said Frank C. Moore shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of December 1924, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Sixteen + 67/100 (\$16.67) Dollars, (\$10.00) Dollars,

being the regular monthly installment payable on the Ten (10) Shares of Stock, and Six + 67/100 (\$6.67) Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of Fifteen + 33/100 (\$15.33) Dollars, (\$10.00) Dollars,

Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and \$33/100 (\$3.33) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of Fourteen + 67/100 (\$14.67) Dollars, (\$10.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and Four + 20/100 (\$4.00) Dollars, (\$12.67) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Twelve + 67/100 (\$12.67) Dollars, (\$10.00) Dollars,

being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and Six + 67/100 (\$6.67) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Eleven + 33/100 (\$11.33) Dollars, (\$10.00) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and \$33/100 (\$3.33) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said Ten (10) shares of stock and the certificate therefor, the amount at such time per shares by to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made, the said Frank C. Moore

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fees which may be duly imposed upon or charged against I the said Frank C. Moore in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN that I, the said Frank C. Moore in consideration of the sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me

the said Frank C. Moore in hand well and lawfully granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

In Greenville Township, near Judson Mills known as Lot No. 68 on plat of lands of Pride & Patton Land Company, made by R.E. Dalton, Engineer, recorded in office of R.M.C. for Greenville County, plat book "E", page 249. Said lot having the following metes and bounds according to said plat beginning at iron pin on South side of Goodrich Street and Valley Streets corner of lot #69 and running thence with Goodrich Street N. 64-49 W. 76.4 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot #67; thence in a southwesterly direction with line of lot No. 67, 135.1 feet to an iron pin joint corner of lots #61, 62, 67 and 68; thence South 59-23 E. 75.35 feet to an iron pin joint corner of lots #60, 61, 68 and 69; thence in a Northeasterly direction with line of lot #69, 142.4 feet to beginning corner, being the same lot of land conveyed to me by C.A. Turner by deed dated March 18th, 1924, and recorded in Volume 92, page 368, R.M.C. office for Greenville County.
