

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

That I, H. W. Inman, of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said H. W. Inman, in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing the 3rd day of November, 1925

I am indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Three Thousand & no/100 (3000.00) Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 3rd day of November A. D. 1925, according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

I the said H. W. Inman shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of November

1925, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of 50.00

Dollars, (30.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the Thirty (30) Shares of Stock, and 20.00

Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of 446.00

Dollars, (30.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and 16.00 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of 442.00

Dollars, (30.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and 12.00 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of 438.00

Dollars, (30.00) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and 8.00 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of 341.00

Dollars, (30.00) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and 4.00 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said Thirty (30) shares of stock and the certificate thereon, the amount at such time paid, to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made I, the said

H. W. Inman, and shall pay or cause to be paid all taxes which may be duly imposed upon or charged against I, the said H. W. Inman

in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder set forth, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said H. W. Inman, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company,

according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me the said

H. W. Inman, in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

to wit: One (1) piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Being lot No. 45 of 1st Division known as McCullough Heights of same being recorded in Plat Book C of Page 95, R. M. C. office for Greenville County. Said lot fronts Verdun Avenue, sixty (60) feet and has a depth of one hundred eighty (180) feet more or less.

(Also, All that other piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, being lot No. 44 of McCullough Heights, plat of same being recorded in Plat Book C, page 95, R. M. C. office for Greenville County. Said lot is situated on the corner of Verdun Avenue and Donnybrook street and fronts Verdun Avenue, sixty one (61) feet and has a depth on Donnybrook street of one hundred eighty (180) feet more or less.
