Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the South side of Hamilton Avenue 200 feet from the intersection of Hamilton Avenue and Calhoun Street and corner of lot 21, and running thence with line of lot 21, S. 16.45 W. 135 feet to a stake; thence S. 77-45 E. 50 feet and one and a half inches to stake corner of lot 13; thence along the line of lot 13 and 12, N. 16-15 E. 131.6 feet to a stake on Hamilton Avenue; thence along line of Hamilton Avenue as a line N. 73.45 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner, being the same land conveyed to me by W.T.
