with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid semi-annually
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount owing by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further provided for an attorney's fee of _____ besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind in which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had; as will more fully appear.

bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Myra L. Cox, her heirs and assigns forever: All that

in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and having the
following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of said
West Washington Street, seven hundred twenty six and one half feet (726-1/2 ft.) west of
Westfield Street, being the corner of the lot formerly owned by Mrs. L.L. Meredith, and
running thence with the line of said lot S. 28-15 W. two hundred twenty and one half
feet (221-1/2 ft.) to an iron pin on Morgan line; thence with said Morgan's line N. 65-45
W. fifty feet (50 ft.) to an iron pin Dean's corner; thence with line of Hobbs N. 28-15
E. two hundred twenty six feet (226 ft.) to an iron pin on the South side of said

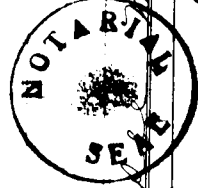
