All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, County and State  
aforesaid, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 on  
plat of R.E. Dalton, May 1913. Lots 1 to 6 inclusive, having the following metes and  
bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Brockman Street, corner of Tom Davis  
property, and running thence S. 15-49 W. 40.2 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing  
with said Street S. 48-32 W. 200.25 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot No. 7; thence  
with line of lot No. 7, S. 45.0 E. 108.8 feet to an iron pin on an unnamed Street;  
thence with said street N. 45.0 E. 243.4 feet to an iron pin, corner of Tom Davis
