at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
bargain, sell and release into the said D. W. Cochrane
All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the County and State aforesaid about
three and one-half miles from Greenville, C.H. on the Augusta Road, being composed of
one lot of one acre, conveyed to me, the said W. R. Lupo, by W. B. McDaniel, and a part of
another lot adjoining same conveyed to me by E. E. Ashmore, the whole lot now mortgaged
having, in the aggregate, the following lines: beginning at a stake on the West side of
the Augusta Road (Lupo's corner) and running thence about S. 13-30 E. 134 feet to a stake
on said road; thence continuing along said road, about S. 15 E. 107.5 feet to the Wade
lot; thence along the Wade lot about S. 80-48 W. 374.5 feet to a stake in old road at the
rear; thence along said old road N. 4-45 E. 97.3 feet to a stake; thence continuing along
