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formerly belonging to Mrs. Austin, and crossing the middle fork of Laurel Creek and the C. & W.C. Railway) 2881 ft. to the center of the west fork of Laurel Creek (this being the east corner of the tract of 54.03 acres conveyed by J.R. Crouch and myself to Liddie Hallum by deed recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances for said County in deed book 79, at page 235); thence up center of said creek following the meanders as the line approximately N. 51° 30' W. about 720 ft. to the center of a bridge by which a plantation road crosses said creek; thence along the center of said road S. 70° 20' W. 126.5 ft. to a stake; thence N. 69° 55' W. (leaving said road, but subsequently crossing it) 1570 ft. to a pile of stones; thence S. 77° 25' W.
