All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the South side of Winal Avenue, being known and designated as Lots Nos. B and C, and a five foot strip off the eastern portion of Lot No. A of Plat of property surveyed by James C. Covington July 25, 1935, for the Receivers of Peoples State Bank of South Carolina, and having in the aggregate, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the South side of Winal Avenue, which point is 68.2 feet west of the Southwest intersection of Winal Avenue and Capers Street, joint corner of lots C and D, and running thence along the joint line of lots C and D, S. 5-15 E. 200.7 feet to a point in the rear line of lot E; thence along the rear line of lots E, F, G and H, 141.4 feet to a point in rear line of lot H; thence N. 5-15 W. 200.7 feet to a point in the south side of Winal Avenue; thence along the south side of Winal Avenue N. 89-32 E. 141.4 feet to the point of beginning.
