All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land North of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and lying partly on the side of Paris Mountain, containing  $143\frac{1}{2}$  acres, and being the same tract conveyed to William F. Austin by Eliza H. Hunt on April 25, 1914, by deed recorded in Volume 28, page 467, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, reference being made to said deed for a more definite description.
