

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

That I, R. W. Neal

of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said R. W. Neal

in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing the 24th day of August 1925

me indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate,

duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Nine Hundred (\$900.00) Dollars,

with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 24th day of August A. D. 1925,

according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that I

the said R. W. Neal shall pay or cause to be paid to the said

Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of September

1925, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of \$15.00

Dollars, (\$9.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the Nine (9) Shares of Stock, and \$6.00

Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the

sum of \$12.80 Dollars, (\$9.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock, and \$4.80 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);

for the next twenty months the sum of \$12.60 Dollars, (\$9.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and \$3.60

Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$11.40

Dollars, (\$7.00 Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and \$4.40 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the

sum of \$10.20 Dollars, (\$9.00 Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and \$1.20 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said Nine (9)

shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by I to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made by, the said

R. W. Neal and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon or charged against I the said R. W. Neal

in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the

said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said R. W. Neal

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company,

according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me

the said R. W. Neal in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is

hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and

Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

All that lot of land on Nichols Street in the City of Greenville being Lot No. 12 Block - fronting said Nichols Street fifty (50) feet and having a depth of One Hundred (100) feet and being the same lot conveyed to me by E. Suman Master, by deed dated November 20th, 1915 and recorded in Deed Book 14, Page 359, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County. All that other piece parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville County and State aforesaid on Sullivan Alley having a frontage of thirty-five (35) feet on said alley with a depth of One Hundred (100) feet and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Clara Maxwell by deed dated February 8th, 1923 and recorded in Deed Book 78, page 500, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.
