Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

in the City of Greenville, on McKay Street, known and designated as lot No. 7 of the property of R.J. Williams, according to a plat and survey made by R.E. Dalton, Engr., November 1924: Beginning at an iron pipe on McKay Street at corner of lot No. 6, and running thence with McKay Street S. 86-14 W. 50 feet to pipe, corner of lot No. 8; thence with line of lot No. 8, N. 3-46 W. 195.6 feet to pipe; thence S. 88-47 E. 50.2 feet to pipe, corner of lot No. 6; thence with line of lot No. 6, S. 3-46 E. 191.3 feet to the beginning corner, being the same conveyed to me by R.J. Williams by deed dated November 13, 1924.
