WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Four thousand no/100

Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

In Greenville Township, being designated upon plat of property of Thos. T. Goldsmith, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, page 113. Beginning at an iron pipe on Cureton Street, joint corner of lots Nos. 6 and 7, and running thence with said Street N. 58-19 E. 50 feet to a stake; thence with line of lot conveyed to Laura Peace Echols 201.55 feet, more or less to a stake; thence S. 53-52 W. 35 feet to an iron pin; thence with line of lot No. 6, N. 34-27 W. 204.3 feet to the beginning corner.

Being the western half of lot No. 7, being the same conveyed to Laura Peace Echols by B.H. Peace by deed dated November 21, 1924, recorded in Book 83, page 388.
