with interest thereon, from **nativity** at the rate of **8** per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid **annually**

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for attorney's fee of **10%** besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings, and all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, refer-
ence being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

being and lying in the State and County aforesaid in the Town of Ft. Inn, and on the west side of Main with the following bounds, to-wit: Bounded by lot of T. E. Jones, Alley on back, Lot of F. W. Welborn and Main Street and being the same lot deeded to me by R. B. Holland, (This is the 3rd. mortgage on this lot, said G. E. Chamblee also holds other two mortgages.)
