interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder  
hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of fifty dollars

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said  
debt, or) any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said

Beginning on a chestnut stump and running thence N. 34-3/4 W. 11.40 chs. to an iron pin,  
Watson's corner; thence S. 38-1/4 W. 18.90 chs. to an iron pin on the branch; thence  
with the branch S. 47-1/2 W. 3.80 chs. to a bend; thence S. 83-1/4 W. 7.15 to a bend; thence  
S. 7 E. 4.90 chs. to an iron pin; thence N. 78-1/2 E. 12.34 chs. to an iron pin; thence N.  
55 E. 18.57 chs. to the beginning corner, and containing 22-55/100 acres, more or less,  
adjoining lands of W.G. Howard, J.L. Watson et al; this is the same land conveyed to me
