hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10 per cent
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said
debt, or) any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said

do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R. D. Dobson,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, having the following meter and bounds: Beginning at the corner of lot #4, on Hilton St. in the city of Greer, and runs thence with said street, N. 8-15 E. 65 feet to the corner of lot #2; thence with the line of this lot N. 79-30 W. 300 feet; thence S. 4-10 E. 67.5 feet to another corner of lot #4; thence with the line of this lot S. 79-30 E. 260 feet to the beginning corner, being designated as lot #3 on a plat of the Mary E. Green property made by W. A. Christopher, Surveyor, March 6th, 1925.
