and also interest upon said principal sum, to be computed from the day of the date hereof, at and after the rate of **eight** per centum per annum, payable semi-annually on the **First** day of **May** in each and every year, and if not so paid each installment of principal and of interest to bear interest at the rate of **eight** per centum per annum after maturity, together with ten per centum upon the amount of principal and interest then due on this note as attorney's fees, if placed in the hands of an attorney for collection under the provisions of a mortgage securing this note:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That **I**, the said **Charles F. All that certain lot or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, near the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot No. 18, in Block "M" of the O.P. Mills subdivision, as shown on plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "C", page 176, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-  
Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of Grove Road, joint corner lots 18 and 19, and running thence with the joint line of said lots N. 53-00 W. 167.2 ft. to an iron pin, in line of lot No. 20; thence with the line of that lot N. 36-37 E. 68 ft. to an iron pin, corner of lot No. 17; thence S. 51-14 E. 152.9 feet to an iron pin on Grove Road; thence with said Road S. 24-06 W. 66 ft. to the point of beginning.
