WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Two Thousand no/100 Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

In Greenville Township, about two miles south west of the City of Greenville, and having the following meter and bounds: Beginning at a stake on the New White Horse Road (also known as Washington Road) 113-1/3 feet from the North-west corner of New White Horse Road and Gordon Street, and running thence with New White Horse Road N. 22 W. 66-2/3 feet to stake; thence S. 79-45-E. 140 feet to stake; thence S. 22 E. 66-2/3 feet to stake in line of Mac Jamison; Trotter; thence with her line N. 79-45-E. 140 feet to the beginning corner, being the same corner as shown on plat of J. H. Childers and J. R. West by deed dated March 24, 1924.
