until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal
or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who

County, South Carolina on Durham Bridge Road and
having the following metes and bounds; to-wit:
Beginning at a sycamore tree on branch and running
thence N. 77-40 E. 566.5 feet to a Pin on an unnamed
road; thence with said unnamed road N. 42 W. 580 feet
to an iron Pin on Plantation road; thence with said
Plantation road S. 38-17 W. 554 feet to an iron Pipe in
said road; thence S. 21 E. 398.5 feet to a Poplar tree;
