Dollars, to be paid *one year from date*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid *Annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal
or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

\$ 50.00 besides all costs and expenses of collection to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference

bargain, sell and release unto the said *Lillia A. Nash, her heirs and assigns*

*all that piece parcel or lot of land situate lying
and being in the State and County aforesaid,
containing Fifteen one Hundredths of an acre, more
or less and in the City of Greenville, on Bernie
Street and described as follows:
Beginning at a stake on Bernie Street and running
thence S. 70 W. 1.35 to a stake; thence S. 42 E. 118 to a
stake; thence N. 70 E. 186 feet to a stake; thence
with Alice Ferguson's line; thence along Bernie
Street N. 62 1/2 W. 156 to the beginning corner. Said
lot lying between Jane Wilson's lot on the C & G
Railroad, and Bernie Street and being a portion
of lot lot 710 E. Survey of H. J. Cook dated
November 12th 1880 and recorded in Book
